COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT

Introduction:

The international award "Premio Internazionale Massimo Urbani" (PIMU) aims to honour the memory of the legendary roman saxophonist Massimo Urbani finding rising young artists, contributing to the development of their artistic careers and to the spread of jazz music.

Art. 1 The "Premio Internazionale Massimo Urbani 2020" (named PIMU) is carried out in a semi-final steps which take place in Rome (1 May), and a final step in Camerino, in the province of Macerata, Marche region on 27 and 28 June 2020.

Art. 2 The competition is open to Italian and foreign jazz soloists playing any instrument (including voice).

Art. 3 Application forms for the Premio Internazionale Massimo Urbani (PIMU) must be sent before the 17th of April 2020 (evidence will be constituted by the date of receipt of the e-mail with all the required material).

Candidates must send their application form, duly filled in, to **segreteria@musicamdo.it attaching the following documents:**

- **Application form** including name, date of birth, address, telephone number and e-mail address (e-mail account is mandatory, all communications will be done via e-mail);
- **Curriculum Vitae (CV);**
- **Good quality files video** with a minimum of 3 jazz standards;
- **A high resolution photo;**
- **Copy of the registration fee payment.**

Art. 4 Candidates will pay a 50,00€ entry fee (as described in the attached application form). In the case of admission to the final stage in Camerino, the entry fee will be completed with the additional payment of 50,00€.

Art. 5 After a first selection through the listening of video and audio files, and within the 20 April 2020, the Artistic Direction will give notice of the candidates admitted to the semi-final stage in Rome at Casa del Jazz (1 May).

Candidates admitted to the final stage in Camerino will be announced after all the semi-final steps.

Art. 6 Premio Massimo Urbani's final step will take place according to the following general schedule:

Camerino (MC), 27 June, Premio Massimo Urbani final stage 2020, admitted candidates will be accompanied by a jazz Trio: Seby Burgio (piano), Massimo Moriconi (double bass), Massimo Manzi (drums).

Camerino (MC) 28 June, Premio Massimo Urbani 2020 Winner live concert.

Art. 7 All candidates will be asked to perform **playing jazz standards.**

Art. 8 During semi-final and final stages, the jury will be composed of the jazz Trio accompanying candidates and of influential musicians, jazz journalists and experts.

Art. 9 The jury will assign the following **awards:**

- **Premio Internazionale Massimo Urbani (PIMU)**, recording, mixing and mastering at Tube Recording Studio, promotion and distribution of the album by Emme Record Label.
- **NUOVO IMAIE Award**, in line with the requirements of the grant received from Nuovo IMAIE, the winner will be awarded with an 8 concerts tour within the following 12 months.
- **Social Award**, to the artist most voted by the web audience.
- **Critics Award**, a special award given by a jury composed of specialized journalists.



- **Scholarships for jazz workshops in Italy like Nuoro Jazz and Fara Music Summer School.**

Art. 10 The Jury reserves the right not to assign the Premio Massimo Urbani Award, according to artistic evaluations.

Art. 11 The organization does not assume any liability for accidents that may happen before, during and after the competition.

Art. 12 Enrolling in the PIMU 2020, all candidates reserve to the organization the right to film or record their public image and performances during PIMU 2020 (including in each case, but not limited to interviews, auditions, photos, etc.) and to use them on all possible communication channels.

Art. 13 Enrolling in the PIMU 2020 imply full acceptance of this competition announcement. The Regulation is published both in Italian and in English language. In the case of any inconsistency, the text in Italian language shall prevail.
